Minutes and MA: The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved with no matters arising.

Officers reports:

Commodore: Reported the presence of a dangerous half flagpole on the west quay which should be removed.

Treasures/Mem sec: Tide tables are on the way. On behalf of Yard Officer reported that parking issues had been dealt with by the installation of a large chain. Tractor needs a new starter motor. Owners of old boats are being advised that unless subs are paid the boats will be sold/destroyed.

Sec: There will be a Seafarers Service at the Methodist Church at 6pm on 23rd Oct. Club insurance has been renewed. Members are reminded that the only hot work to be undertaken is grinding and the use of naked flames is not insured. Mud working group initiative is to be restarted.
